14	The Commissioner of the State of Nevada, Department of Business and Industry, Division of
15	Mortgage Lending ("the Commissioner") having been statutorily charged with the responsibility and
16	authority to administer and enforce Chapter 645F of the Nevada Revised Statutes and Chapter 645F of
17	the Nevada Administrative Code (collectively, "the Act"), governing the licensing and conduct of
18	mortgage servicers doing business in the State of Nevada; and,
19	The Commissioner having been vested with general supervisory power and control over all
20	covered service providers and associated covered service providers doing business in the State of Nevada
21	pursuant to the Act; and,
22	NOVAD MANAGEMENT CONSULTING, LLC ("NOVAD") is and/or was engaged in activity
23	requiring licensure as a mortgage servicer under the Act and therefore subject to the jurisdiction of the
24	Commissioner; and,
25	The Division of Mortgage Lending ("the Division") having commenced an investigation of
26	NOVAD's business practices, pursuant to NRS 645F.530(2) and having determined, from that
27	investigation, that NOVAD was and is engaged in activity requiring licensure as a mortgage servicer
28	under the Statute and that NOVAD does not and does not have the required licensure; and,
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1 NOVAD having been served on or about December 9, 2020, with an Order to Cease and Desist 2 and Order Imposing an Administrative Fine and Investigative Costs, providing NOVAD with (1) notice 3 of facts or conduct which warrant disciplinary action against NOVAD, (2) a notice of opportunity for an 4 administrative hearing; and (3) a notice of an opportunity for an informal conference, prior to the 5 commencement of formal disciplinary action, to show compliance with all lawful requirements; and, 6 NOVAD having exercised their right to an informal conference and that conference being held 7 via videoconference on June 1, 2021, attended by Division staff and Division counsel and Counsel for 8 NOVAD, Mr. Marlon Griffith, Esq. At the conference NOVAD stated its conduct was not intended to 9 violate the Act and was done without the belief that a license was required; and, 10 The Division and NOVAD having conferred at the conference and via email and telephonic 11 conversations between Division counsel and NOVAD's counsel, for the purpose of resolving this matter 12 without the time and expense of a protracted evidentiary hearing, determined to resolve this matter 13 pursuant to the following terms: 14 NOVAD neither admits nor denies in engaging in activity and conduct contrary to 1. 15 NRS 645F.510; and, 16 2. NOVAD agrees to pay the Division an administrative fine in the amount of 17 \$10,000; and, 18 3. NOVAD agrees to pay the Division the Division's administrative and other costs 19 in the amount of \$1,300, and, 20 4. NOVAD agrees to, within eight months of the entrance of this Consent Order, 21 apply for and make a good faith effort to obtain the proper mortgage servicer license issued by the Nevada 22 Mortgage Lending Division, and, 23 NOVAD, by and through counsel, having knowingly and voluntarily affixed a signature to the 24 attached VOLUNTARY CONSENT TO ENTRY OF COMMISSIONER'S CONSENT ORDER (the 25 "Voluntary Consent"), incorporated herein by this reference, has consented to the issuance of this 26 Consent Order ("the Order") with the intent to be legally bound hereby, and having waived and 27 relinquished any and all rights that NOVAD may now or hereafter have to attend an administrative 28 -2-

1	hearing in this matter or to judicial review thereof, or otherwise challenge or contest, the entry of this	
2	Order; and,	
3	NOVAD, having consulted with legal counsel of their choosing concerning this matter; and,	
4	The Commissioner having determined that the terms of this Order are a reasonable resolution of	
5	this matter and in the public interest.	
6	NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:	
7	1. NOVAD shall pay to the Division an Administrative fine in the amount of	
8	\$10,000. The Administrative fine shall be and is due upon NOVAD's execution of the attached Voluntary	
9	Consent and shall be tendered to the Division in accordance with the instructions included in the enclosed	
10	invoice.	
П	2. NOVAD shall pay to the Division the Division's administrative and other costs in	
12	the amount of \$1,300. The Administrative costs shall be and is due upon NOVAD's execution of the	
13	attached Voluntary Consent and shall be tendered to the Division in accordance with the instructions	
14	included in the enclosed invoice.	
15	3. NOVAD shall, within eight months of the entrance of this Consent Order, apply	
16	for and make a good faith effort to obtain the proper mortgage servicer license issued by the Nevada	
17	Mortgage Lending Division.	
18	4. This Order shall be and is effective and enforceable on the date that it is issued, as	
19	shown in the caption hereof.	
20	5. This Order shall remain effective and enforceable until terminated, modified, set	1000
21	aside, or suspended in writing by the Commissioner.	ſ
22	6. The Commissioner specifically retains jurisdiction over the matters contained	-
23	herein and has the authority to issue such further orders as she shall deem just, necessary, and appropriate	-01
24	to enforce the provisions of the Act and to protect the public.	-2000
