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CHAOS having been served on or about July 26, 2021, with a Notice of Intent to Issue Final Order Imposing and Administrative Fine and Investigative Costs, and Notice of Opportunity for Administrative Hearing, providing CHAOS with (1) notice of facts or conduct which warrant disciplinary action against CHAOS, (2) a notice of opportunity for an administrative hearing; and (3) a notice of an opportunity for an informal conference, prior to the commencement of formal disciplinary action, to show compliance with all lawful requirements; and,

CHAOS having exercised their right to an informal conference and that conference being held on September 27, 2021, attended by Division staff and Division counsel and counsel for CHAOS, Mr. Joseph J. Tirello, Esq. At the conference CHAOS stated its conduct did not violate the Act; and,
